Virtual Conference/Livestream FAQ's

- Do I login to the conference and watch it on my computer or tablet?
Yes. Once you are registered, the links to view all sessions for Day 1 and Day 2 will be posted within the SCHED application 24 hours in advance of the conference date.
- Will the conference be available via YouTube? Zoom?
No, the video feed is live and provided by ESC Region 13 thru the website livestream.com. The video feed will be embedded within each session listed within the SCHED conference planning tool.
- Is there an opportunity to check my device settings for the webinar?

- What is SCHED?
SCHED is a digital conference program and planning tool. It is accessible via the web or mobile device with the SCHED App. Registered participants will be emailed the unique event URL and password closer to the event.
- What breakout sessions are included with the Virtual Conference?
All scheduled sessions will be available via livestream. The conference includes two keynote speakers and 18 breakout sessions over two days.
- May I ask questions?
Participants will not have the ability to “un-mute” themselves to ask questions during the sessions. The level of interaction during each session may differ and is dependent on the tools used by the presenter.
- Can I receive [TSHA/TAPA/TOTA](#) CEU credit for watching the Livestream?
Yes, registered participants who are eligible to receive CEU credits will receive information closer to the event on how to certify their attendance during the conference to earn credits.

- Can I receive Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credits for attending this virtual conference?

Educators are eligible to receive Continuing Professional Education (CPE) credit upon completion of the online conference evaluation. Email notifications will be sent out with instructions for evaluation and certificate.
